



JF CUP SX U12 - U14 Samedi 13 et dimanche 14 avril 2024

1. ORGANIZATION

The 6th edition of the JF FIGHT SKI CUP is organized by the Club des Sports de Val Thorens in partnership with the Val Thorens resort and its various services.

The different international competitions take place at the Ski Cross Stadium Jean-Frédéric CHAPUIS (access TSD des 2 Lacs) and are reserved for Ski Clubs and children with a French or foreign Carte Neige Compétiteur license.

Saturday 13/04: Qualification and final day reserved for U12 categories Sunday 14/04: Qualification and final day reserved for U14 categories

2. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

Minimum required level: flèche – Competitor License, Helmet, and back protector mandatory. Wearing a suit is prohibited, mandatory attire (ski pants + softshell).

For foreign racers, no FIS license is required. A competitor license from their country, a copy of their passport, and a signed FIS "waiver" by themselves, their parents, or legal guardian will be required to participate in these races.

3. **REGISTRATION**

The participation fee is set at €20 per person. It includes registration, barbecue, lift pass, and entertainment.

To validate registrations, 2 steps are necessary: Proceed with the payment for the race via the following link: <u>JF CUP 2024 Registration</u>

1. RACE REGULATIONS

Training and qualifications will be done in groups of 1, 2, 3, or 4 (timing by transponder). Multiple runs will be possible, and the best time will be recorded for the final phases. The finals will be held with 16 or 32 participants depending on the number of entries. Any deliberate obstruction or change of line during qualification and final phases will result in disqualification.

Gate controllers will be placed along the course to ensure the smooth running of the race and fair play behavior of competitors.

5. RANKINGS

During qualification phases, all racers will be timed (multiple runs will be possible, and the best time will be recorded) using a transponder. Rankings will be established by category. The overall winners (girls & boys) and the best club will receive a special prize.

6. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

Each participant must be insured for accidents with a valid national license covering competitive skiing.

The Organizing Committee declines all responsibility for any consequences of accidents or material damages that may occur outside of training or competition periods.

7. CANCELLATION

Depending on weather and safety conditions on the day, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the event. There will be no possibility of rescheduling, and cancellation will not entitle to any refunds.

8. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation packages will be offered by the Reservation Center for this competition from €40/person/night.
